Who can play?

Children born 2015 (U4) through 2006 (U13)

What do players need?

Soccer cleats, shin guards, soccer socks, water bottle

(there is a SWAP BOX of Gently Used Soccer Gear at Barriere Elementary School in the Primary Wing Hallway – take or leave what you like)

What is the cost?

U4-U6 \$40 (includes Jersey use and Photos) - Saturdays only

U7-U13 \$55 (includes Jersey use and Photos) - practice Mondays, games Wednesdays.

Registration fee also includes the Clearwater Tournament May (date TBD)

How to Register? *Registration starts Feb. 15th through March 30th.*
